Section 01

Acceptance of Terms.

The following constitute the official Terms of Use governing Nuclear v1.0. By obtaining a Nuclear address whether an existing address or a newly created one you are considered to have read, understood, and unconditionally accepted all terms and conditions set forth herein as they apply to Nuclear v1.0. If you do not agree with any provision contained within these terms, you are required to discontinue your use of Nuclear immediately.

Section 02

Nuclear Address Management and Termination.

Nuclear v1.0 does not include any built-in system or mechanism for the removal, deletion, or erasure of a Nuclear address, its associated footprint, or its seven-layer highcrypted data files within the software. Users retain the ability to manually remove their local scrap data including documents/nuclear folder from their own device storage at their discretion. Nuclear v1.0 does not provide any in-application deletion functionality for stored data of any kind. Nuclear operates under the Web7 protocol, within which the deletion of data is considered contrary to the foundational principles governing Web7's integrity and its standing within the broader internet infrastructure. Accordingly, no data deletion feature is provided or supported.

Section 03

Acceptable Use: Assumption by the Nuclear Core Team.

By accessing and utilising the services provided by Nuclear v1.0, it is assumed on behalf of the Nuclear Core Team that each user will engage with the software solely for lawful purposes. Specifically, it is assumed that Nuclear will not be used for any activity that is prohibited by applicable governmental authorities, or that constitutes a threat to national security, social order, or human civilisation in any form.

Section 04

Intellectual Property: Nuclear Core Team.

Every instance of the Nuclear v1.0 software, in its unmodified and original distributed form, constitutes the exclusive intellectual property of the Nuclear Core Team.
