## **Acceptance of Privacy policy.**

The following constitute the official privacy governing Nuclear v1.0. By obtaining a Nuclear address whether an existing address or a newly created one you are considered to have read, understood, and unconditionally accepted all privacy policy, set forth herein as they apply to Nuclear v1.0. If you do not agree with any provision contained within these privacy policies and instructions, you are required to discontinue your use of Nuclear immediately.

## ***Section 02***

### **Introduction and Scope.**

The Nuclear Core Team, as the official creator and worldwide distributor of Nuclear v1.0, hereby presents this Privacy Policy to all users of the Nuclear application across the globe. This document has been prepared with the sincere intent of providing complete transparency regarding the privacy principles, data handling practices, and related service characteristics that govern Nuclear v1.0. The Nuclear Core Team considers the establishment and communication of these privacy policies to be a fundamental and necessary obligation toward its global user base, and this document reflects that commitment in its entirety.

## ***Section 03***

### **Personal Data.**

The Nuclear Core Team does not collect, access, process, or store any form of personal data belonging to its users. Nuclear v1.0 operates without any online servers or external data storage infrastructure of any kind. The Nuclear Core Team functions exclusively as the creator and official distributor of Nuclear v1.0. All data entered by the user within the application, in accordance with its operational requirements, is stored entirely and exclusively on the user's own local device. The Nuclear Core Team has no access to, or knowledge of, any user's subscription payment details or financial information of any kind. Furthermore, the public IP address displayed on the Fusion page of Nuclear v1.0 is a locally referenced value used solely to facilitate Transformer transfers within the application. This address is never transmitted to, or stored on, any external server. These practices reflect the Nuclear Core Team's firm commitment to building user trust and fulfilling the highest standards of operational transparency.

## ***Section 04***

### **Purpose of This Privacy Standard.**

Nuclear v1.0 has been developed with a primary focus on delivering deep, reliable, and uncompromised privacy for individuals and organisations whose communication and operational requirements demand the highest level of discretion and security. The software is intended to serve a broad spectrum of users, including but not limited to individuals seeking secure private communication, professionals managing confidential partnerships,

members of closed societies, military personnel, government officers, business leaders, and those engaged in privately conducted enterprise and network development. The nature of these use cases necessitated the creation of a software environment built entirely around the principle of privacy-first architecture, which Nuclear v1.0 fulfils through its core design and the Web7 protocol framework.

### *Section 05*

#### **Cookies, Tracking Technologies, and Analytics.**

Nuclear v1.0 does not utilise cookies, behavioural tracking mechanisms, analytical tools, or any form of technology designed to monitor, record, or interpret user activity, behaviour, or lifestyle patterns within the application. No such tracking data is collected, processed, or transmitted by Nuclear v1.0 under any circumstance.

### *Section 06*

#### **Online Translation Support.**

Nuclear v1.0 incorporates online translation support as a functional feature within the current release. This translation system operates by processing only the relevant title strings from within Nuclear for the sole purpose of rendering translated output. This data interaction is limited in scope, transient in duration, and strictly confined to non-personal title-level content. No personal data, user files, or any other form of sensitive information is transmitted to the translation system at any point. The Nuclear Core Team confirms that this secure practice will remain unchanged in all future developments of the software.

### *Section 07*

#### **Highcryption Technology.**

Highcryption is a proprietary technology developed by the Nuclear Core Team and is fundamentally distinct from conventional encryption methods. It operates through a completely randomised, seven-layered code generation process that fully transforms all information pertaining to data files and associated content, in full accordance with the principles of the Web7 protocol. Highcryption represents a core architectural component of Nuclear v1.0, designed to ensure that all stored and transferred data remains protected at the highest possible level of technical security.

## ***Section 08***

### **Data Retention.**

Nuclear v1.0 retains all user data indefinitely for the entire duration of the software's active use. In accordance with the foundational principles of the Web7 protocol, data is not subject to deletion within the Nuclear environment. As the software continues to be used, data files and associated secured information will accumulate continuously over time. This retention model is an inherent and intentional characteristic of Nuclear v1.0 and the broader Web7 framework under which it operates.

## ***Section 09***

### **Children's Privacy.**

The Nuclear Core Team does not produce, recommend, or distribute any form of content, consumer-facing services, or targeted offerings of any kind within Nuclear v1.0. All data entered into the application and all output generated through its Transformer functions are entirely determined by the user. No action taken by the Nuclear Core Team within the scope of Nuclear v1.0 compromises or engages with the privacy of minors in any form. It is further assumed by the Nuclear Core Team that all users of Nuclear v1.0 will remain fully compliant with the applicable governmental regulations and guidelines pertaining to child safety in the context of internet services and digital platforms.

### **International Data Transfers.**

Nuclear v1.0 provides users with access to the Fusion page system, which enables the transmission of Transformers to any other Nuclear address freely and securely, including across international boundaries. All such transmissions are conducted exclusively in seven-layered Highcrypted form, ensuring that the integrity and confidentiality of the transferred data is fully preserved throughout the process, regardless of geographic origin or destination.

This Privacy Policy represents the initial official release of the privacy framework governing Nuclear v1.0.
